

## Health Snippet - Rest

Get to bed before 9:00 PM: 1 hour of sleep before midnight is equal to 2 -3 hours sleep after midnight. 6-8 hours sleep is essential, during sleep the body and mental functions are restored.

<u>Resolves</u> - Irritability, Memory loss, Depression, Grief, Anxiety, Discontentment, Remorse, Guilt, Distrust, Body repairs, Concentration difficulty, Prevents disease, etc...

#### REST: (as I like to call as Vitamin R) Comes in four Kinds:

<u>Vitamin R1 is Sleep or daily rest</u> - If you do not feel wide awake & energetic throughout your waking hours, you are likely sleeping too little. Sleeping <8 hours per night makes you unhappy, less attractive, less intelligent, more hungry, out of shape, less fertile and vulnerable: cancer, diabetes, cardiovascular disease, Alzheimer's, etc...

<u>Vitamin R2 is Recreation</u> - We need to take time to get away from work, physical tensions, and mental stresses of life. Activities such as gardening, hiking, sports, cross country skiing, walking, and dozens of other options. These activities provide a mental break from the routine. *GOOD STRESS RELIVER – STRESS: ROOT OF MOST DIEASES*.

<u>Vitamin R3 is Meditation</u> - Is also essential and should be done at least on a daily basis. Prayer is the breath of the soul, figuratively speaking. <u>Meditation: Study of Bible & Prayer: Talking to God</u> - Both provide mental rest that is potent form of release from stress, tension, anxiety, depression, irritability, guilt, discontentment, etc.

<u>Vitamin R4 is the Weekly rest</u> - In addition to sleeping each night, we need a weekly day of rest. Just as the body has a natural daily clock (circadian rhythm), it also has a weekly clock (circaseptan rhythm). Circaseptan rhythms are just that: body rhythms that run about seven days in length. Because God made it so and such a priority is one of the beauties of God's 4<sup>th</sup> (Sabbath) Commandment. — Genesis 2:1-3 & Exodus 20:8-11.

<u>Finally</u>: Do you need to read sentences twice? Do you feel drowsiness a few hours after waking up? Do you always wake up with an alarm instead of waking up naturally? - It's a clear sign of sleep deficit!



### High Priests work

• "In the typical system, which was a shadow of the sacrifice and priesthood of Christ, the cleansing of the sanctuary was the last service **performed by the high priest** in the yearly round of ministration. It was the closing work of the atonement --a removal or putting away of sin from Israel. It prefigured the closing work in the ministration of our High Priest in heaven, in the removal or blotting out of the sins of His people, which are registered in the heavenly records."

#### WHERE DOES GOD LIVE?

God dwells in His Sanctuary in Heaven; "the true tabernacle which the Lord erected, and not man" (Heb. 8:2). The earthly sanctuary was "the copy and shadow" of that sanctuary (Heb. 8:5)

What does God do at the heavenly Sanctuary?

- 1. He governs, His throne is there.
- He receives all worship.
- He passes judgment.
- 4. He ministers for our salvation.

And hearken thou to the supplication of thy servant, and of thy people Israel, when they shall pray toward this place: and hear thou in heaven thy dwelling place: and when thou hearest, forgive. 1 Kings 8:30

#### THE PLACE WHERE GOD GOVERNS

## The Heavenly Sanctuary THE PLACE WHERE GOD IS WORSHIPPED

John saw the Throne of God in Revelation 4 and 5—the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit were there. It was surrounded by the four living creatures, 24 elders and millions of angels.



A sea of glass was before the throne. That's where God meets His creatures when they come to Him (Rev. 15:2) God receives worship from every creating being there.

And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever. And the four beasts said, Amen. And the four and twenty elders fell down and worshipped him that liveth for ever and ever. - Revelation 5:13-14



"The church of God below is one with the church of God above. Believers on the earth and the beings in heaven who have never fallen constitute one church. Every heavenly intelligence is interested in the assemblies of the saints who on earth meet to worship God. #### THE PLACE WHERE GOD PASSES JUDGMENT

But the LORD shall endure for ever: he hath prepared his throne for judgment. – Psalms 9:7

Since sin entered the world, the heavenly Sanctuary is also the judgment court now. Saints and sinners are judged there.

God's government is based upon justice and mercy, so we can be confident of His right judgment. His sentence is unappealable.

But the LORD *is* in his holy temple: let all the earth keep silence before him.

– Habakkuk 2:20







#### THE PLACE WHERE GOD SAVES

Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them. – Hebrews 7:25

Where does Jesus intercede on our behalf? Where does He get eternal salvation for us?

Now of the things which we have spoken *this is* the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens; A minister of the sanctuary, and of the true tabernacle, which the Lord pitched, and not man. – Hebrews 8:1-2

"Christ is in the heavenly sanctuary, and he is there to make an atonement for the people. He is there to present his wounded side and pierced hands to his Father. He is there to plead for his Church that is upon the earth. He is cleansing the sanctuary from the sins of the people"

#### A GLIMPSE OF THE HEAVENLY SANCTUARY

Sanctuary imagery appears all along the Revelation book. In fact, most of the major sections of the book begin with or contain a sanctuary scene.



The first introductory scene shows Christ, clothed as High Priest, walking among the seven lampstands (Rev. 1:12-20)



The second shows the heavenly throne room; there is a throne, lamps, a sea, a slain Lamb, blood, and golden bowls of incense (Rev. 4, 5)



The third scene refers to the continual service of intercession in the context of the first apartment of the heavenly sanctuary (Rev. 8:2-6)



The fourth and central scene gives us a glimpse of the ark of the covenant in the second apartment (Rev. 11:19)



The fifth scene brings the entire tabernacle in heaven into view (Rev. 15:5-8)



The sixth scene is unique in that it does not contain any explicit references to the sanctuary, perhaps to illustrate that Christ's work there is finished (Rev. 19:1-10)



The final scene is all about the glorious Holy City on earth, which is portrayed as the tabernacle "coming down out of heaven"


(Rev. 21:1-8,

Those verses show a progression in salvation: from Christ on earth, to His heavenly ministry and finally to the new earth tabernacle.

## The Sanctuary: Hebrews 8:5 "Shadow of the heavenly things"

What is in heaven became a replica on Earth when Israel created the Sanctuary; Within the Sanctuary was the ark of the covenant. ON the ark were two cherubs COVERING the Mercy seat. The Mercy seat represents the throne of God. Within the Ark was the ten commandments (God's Holy Law).




## The role of the two Cherubims

 And the priests brought in the ark of the covenant of the LORD unto his place, into the oracle of the house, to the most holy place, even under the wings of the cherubims.


 For the cherubims spread forth their two wings over the place of the ark, and the cherubims covered the ark and the staves thereof above. 1 Kings 8:6-7










  - Recorded sin/covered by blood of sacrifice
- Trim candlestick wicks, and replenish oil

## The Sanctuary Service - Exodus 40 In a nutshell, here's how it worked:


- When a sinner wanted to ask God's forgiveness, he will have to **enter the sanctuary gate** with an unblemished animal (lamb, goat, pigeon).
- The sinner will confess the sins to the sacrificial animal.
- The ministering priest will burn the animal's flesh as a sacrifice.
- The priest will then wash his hands in the laver or basin.
- In the Holy Place, the priest will make sure that the Table of Showbread has fresh 12 loaves on it, the Seven candlesticks are filled with oil and are regularly burning, and that the censer is continuously flourishing its sweet-smelling incense.



 The high priest enters the Most Holy Place once a year and acts as the mediator pleading for the nation of Israel to God; and if successful, he will go out of the sanctuary to proclaim God's mercy and grace to the people.

#### "The Daily" is mentioned in five verses of the Bible, all found in the book of Daniel.

- (1) 8:11 Yea, he magnified [himself] even to the prince of the host, and by him the daily [sacrifice] was taken away, and the place of his sanctuary was cast down.
- (2) 8:12 And an host was given [him] against the daily [sacrifice] by reason of transgression, and it cast down the truth to the ground; and it practiced, and prospered.
- (3) 8:13 Then I heard one saint speaking, and another saint said unto that certain [saint] which spake, How long [shall be] the vision [concerning] the daily [sacrifice], and the transgression of desolation, to give both the sanctuary and the host to be trodden under foot?
- (4) 11:31 And arms shall stand on his part, and they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength, and shall take away **the daily** [sacrifice], and they shall place the abomination that maketh desolate.
- (5) 12:11 And from the time [that] the daily [sacrifice] shall be taken away, and the abomination that maketh desolate set up, [there shall be] a thousand two hundred and ninety days.

### Need to understand - "The Daily"



The word tamid, "daily," is frequently found describing aspects of the Jewish sanctuary services and ministration. e.g. ",,,the continual [tamid] shewbread..." 2 Chronicles 2:4 " "...the continual [tamid] meat offering, and for the continual [tamid] burnt offering..." Nehemiah 10:33 "...a perpetual [tamid] incense..." Exodus 30:8

"Tamid" was used to indicate the continual nature of these things which typified Christ's continual ministry. Christ "ever liveth to make intercession" (Heb. 7:25).



#### Need to understand - "The Daily"

Some have been led to conclude that the term "ha tamid [the daily] refers to the entire sanctuary ministration, and not just the sacrifice, although admittedly, the word tamid is never used on its own any where in Scripture, to refer to the sanctuary ministration, unless it is here in Daniel.

The sanctuary services were a type of Christ's ministry in heaven (Hebrews 8:2-5) and many believe that the daily refers to Christ's continual heavenly ministry. Therefore the taking away of the daily would refer to the taking away or obscuring the truth of, Christ's heavenly ministry. This, papal Rome is said to have done by substituting a counterfeit human ministry on earth by diverting men's attention from Christ and the benefits of His ministry.



## The taking away of the "daily" refers to the substitution, by the Papacy, of:


- 1. Compulsory unity in a visible church in place of the voluntary unity of all believers in Christ.
- 2. A visible authority and visible head the Pope in place of Christ, the invisible authority & head of the church.
- 3. A priestly hierarchy in place of direct access to Christ our only Mediator (1 Timothy 2:5).
- 4. A system of salvation by works ordained by the church in place of salvation by faith in Christ (Ephesians 2:8-9).
- 5. Most particularly, the confessional and the sacrifice of the mass in place of the Christ's once for all sacrifice (Hebrews 10:10) and His mediatorial work as our great high priest in the heavenly sanctuary (Hebrews 8:1; 9:11).



#### The Sanctuary

- This is how the heavenly Sanctuary was trodden under foot
- The Sanctuary trodden under foot was to be cleansed
- The final phase of the Sanctuary services in O. T. times was portrayed with the Day of Atonement. (removing sin)
- This service prefigured the great judgment day at the end of the world.
- This service had been lost sight of and needed to be restored, putting Jesus back as High Priest and forgiver of sin and remover of sin, finally from the Sanctuary.
- The restoration and the cleansing of the Temple on the Day of Atonement was to commence at the end of the 2300 year prophecy.


#### God reveals His Sanctuary & Judgement


It was a significant turning point in the spiritual lives of those present and a significant moment in Millerite Adventism, for it presented the first glimmer of a new movement to come. That morning after their prayer meeting and breakfast Hiram Edson suggested to his little group that they should go out an encourage some of their other brethren. As they were making their way across a large field Edson stopped dead in his tracks, staring intently ahead of him.

Edson was presented with a vision of the heavenly sanctuary where he was shown Jesus entering the Most Holy place for the first time on October 22nd, 1844. Instead of the 2300 day prophecy pointing to Jesus second coming, it was presented to him, that Jesus had entered the Most Holy place of the heavenly sanctuary because he had work to do there.










#### Revelation 3:7+8








# The Jews trampled upon the Sanctuary

The Jewish nation had rejected the Lamb of God (altar of sacrifice), the Water of Life (laver), the Bread of Life (table of showbread), the Light of the world (candlestick), His intercession for them (altar of incense), and the law of God (ark of the covenant). They had, in essence, rejected the very purpose for which the blueprint had been given to them. The temple on earth was no longer sanctified by God's presence. In fact, Rome destroyed the temple and Jerusalem in AD 70, and a temple has never been rebuilt since, nor will be.





"The commandments of God given to Moses in the Mount at Horeb are as binding today as ever they have been since the time when they were proclaimed in the hearing of the people. The Jews said the law was not given in Palestine, which belonged to Israel, but in the wilderness, because the law was for all nations.

Jesus never condemned the law and the prophets, but He did condemn those who did not obey them. Because He gave new commandments it does not follow that He abolished the old. Christ's explanation of them me them all the more searching. In His Sermon on the Mount, He carried the principles of the commandments beyond the mere letter. He unfolded them and showed that they embraced more, that they are positive as well as prohibitive" (Weighed and Wanting, Chicago: Revell, 1898, p. 15).


After the fall of the Roman Empire, the Church of Rome, or "spiritual Rome: Papal Rome," arose to take its place. Early on, the church began to teach and practice dogma contrary to the Word of God.

They began to teach that the sacrifice of Christ was not sufficient for the forgiveness of sins. In order to be forgiven, one had to perform penances and pay indulgences.

By this teaching, the sacrifice of Christ was cast down and man began to look elsewhere for the forgiveness of his sins.

# The Laver

The little horn (Papal Rome) further sullied the character of God by teaching that He destroyed infants in hell who had done neither good nor evil. So in order to save them, these infants needed to be baptized shortly after birth, introducing infant sprinkling.

Baptism: no need for a adult to confess sins, die to self, go into a watery grave, come up new life in Christ, but rather something given to every infant at birth.

Hence, true baptism by immersion and repentance was by and large removed.

"The Council of Tarragona (1234 AD), in its second canon, ruled that: 'No one may possess the books of the Old and New Testaments, and if anyone possesses them he must turn them over to the local bishop within eight days, so that they may be burned'" (D. Lortsch, Historie de la Bible en France, 1910, p.14).

Hebrews 7:25, 1 Thessalonians 5:17 The little horn (Papal Rome) also taught that God did not like the prayers of the average person, so that only the priests could offer up prayers in their behalf. The tabernacle building was itself replicated by the church.

A two-compartment room divided by a veil, called a "confessional booth," was set up for a priest to sit in the place of God, behind the veil, while believers would come to confess to them their sins.

The priests took the authority of God by claiming to have the power to forgive sins.

- Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.
- Thou shalt not kill.
- Thou shalt not commit adultery.
- VIII. Thou shalt not steal.

# 1,260 Years of Papal Dominance

 Historians acknowledge that spiritual Rome has indeed ruled for more than a thousand years. "The [Roman Church] became supreme in Christendom in AD 538 due to a letter of the Roman Emperor Justinian, known as Justinian's decree, which setup and acknowledged the bishop of Rome as the head of all churches. It gave the [Roman Church] political power, civil power, as well as ecclesiastical power. This letter became part of Justinian's code, the fundamental law of the empire, and that year, Pope Vigilius ascended the throne under the military protection of Belasarius" (The History of the Christian Church, Vol. 3).




# Satan works through history & even now
