Health Snippet – Babaco

Health Benefits of Babaco (Seek Medical Advice)

Babaco (*Vasconcellea × heilbornii*) called "champagne fruit,". Long torpedo-shaped with a pentagonal cross-section when sliced. It's golden yellow when ripe.

Improved Digestion: is high in papain, a proteolytic enzyme that eases issues like bloating and constipation.

Immune Support: high in Vitamin C which bolsters white blood cell production & overall immune function.

Antioxidant and Anti-inflammatory Action: high concentration of flavonoids and phenolic compounds. These combat oxidative stress, lower inflammation, and may offer anti-cancer and anti-aging properties.

Blood Sugar Management: has exceptionally low glycaemic index and low sugar content, great, safe fruit.

Heart and Bone Health: has potassium, which aids in regulating blood pressure, along with some bone-strengthening minerals like calcium and magnesium.

Skin Health: beta-carotene and Vitamin C support collagen production, helping to protect the skin and delay signs of aging.

Side effects: Digestive Discomfort & Allergic Reactions.

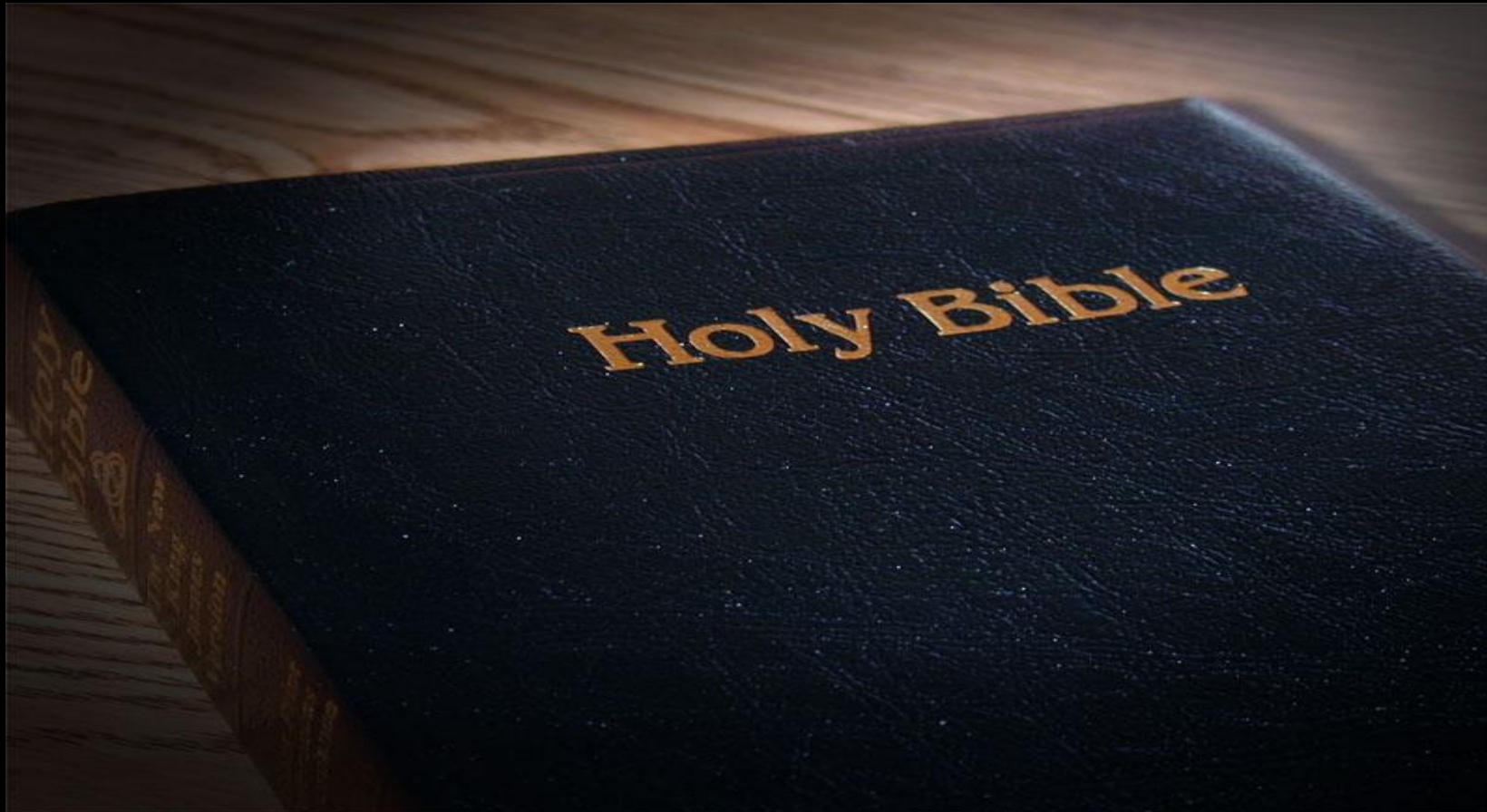

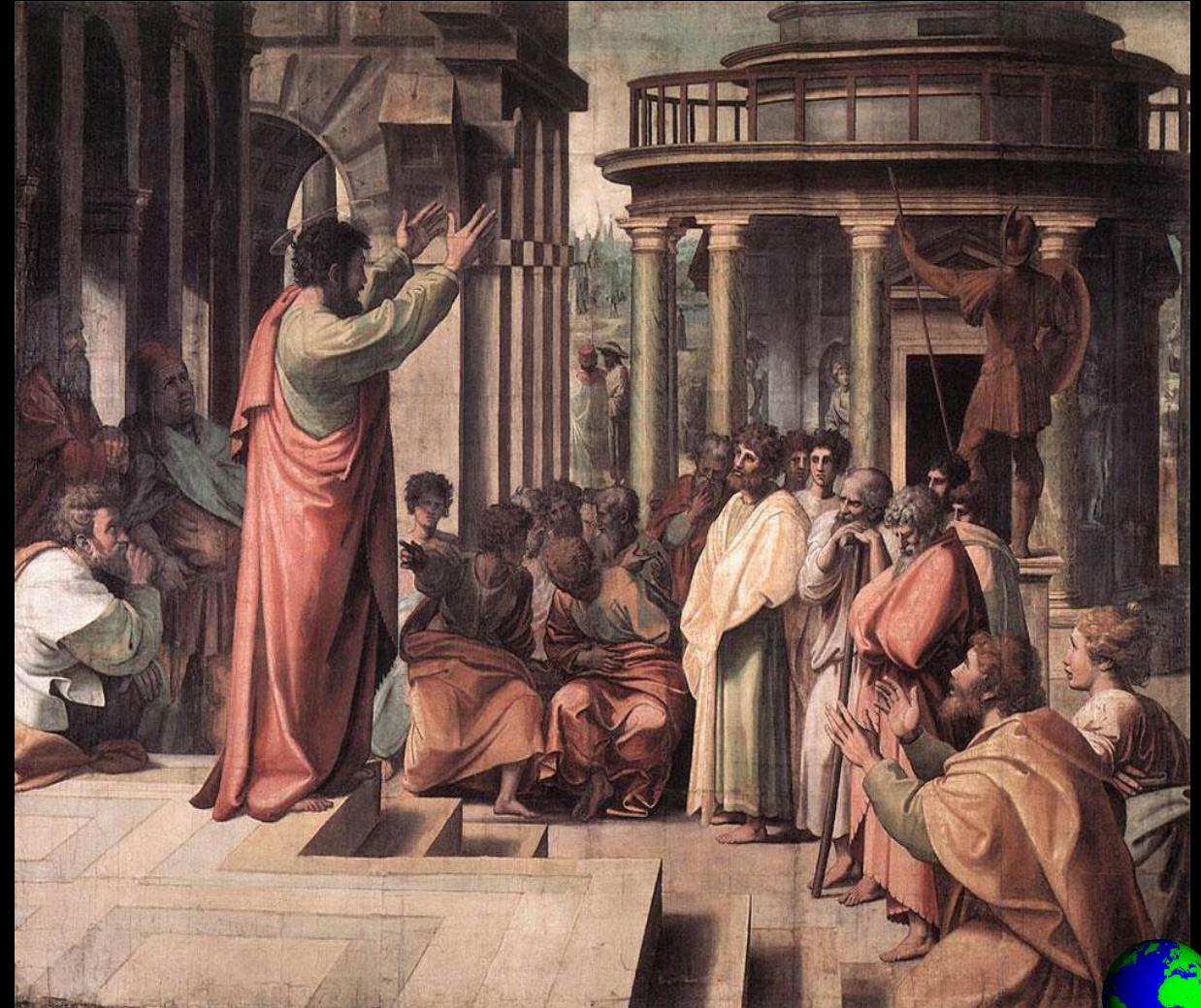
Introduction

1. The Jerusalem Council (Acts 15)

The Decree (Acts 15:28):

The council asked Gentiles to abstain from meats offered to idols, blood, things strangled, and fornication.

The council rejected the idea of incorporating Jewish ceremonial rites into Christian faith. This decision separated the moral law (like the Ten Commandments) from the obsolete ceremonial law, protecting the church from the "yoke" of legalism while upholding basic moral standards.



Introduction

2. Paul's Missionary Journeys (Acts 16–21)

The Holy Spirit's Guidance:

Repeatedly, the Holy Spirit redirects Paul's path (e.g., the Macedonian call in [Acts 16](#)), highlighting the theme that the gospel is a worldwide movement.

The Philippian Jailer ([Acts 16](#)):

The cry, "*What must I do to be saved?*" is answered with the simple, central theme of the book: "*Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved.*"



Introduction

3. Trials, Captivity, and Rome (Acts 22–28)

Fulfilling God's Plan:

Though Paul is in chains, the theme of gospel advancement remains unbroken.

Imprisonment becomes a strategic opportunity for him to preach the kingdom of God to high-ranking officials.

Faithfulness to the End:

Paul embodies the prophetic mission in Acts 1:8, standing as a faithful witness of Jesus Christ in the very heart of the Gentile world—Rome itself.

3 - Lessons in the book of Acts

1. Communal Decision-Making and Church Authority (Acts 15)

The Principle of Unity:

When faced with the Judaizer controversy—individuals trying to impose circumcision and Jewish rituals for salvation—the early church avoided fracturing. They gathered in the Jerusalem Council to pray, study Scripture, and seek Spirit-led consensus.



3 - Lessons in the book of Acts

2. Upholding God's Moral Law (Acts 15:28-29)

The Apostolic Decree:

The council concluded that salvation is by grace, releasing Gentiles from ceremonial requirements like circumcision. However, they strictly commanded Gentiles to abstain from idolatry, blood, strangled meat, and sexual immorality.

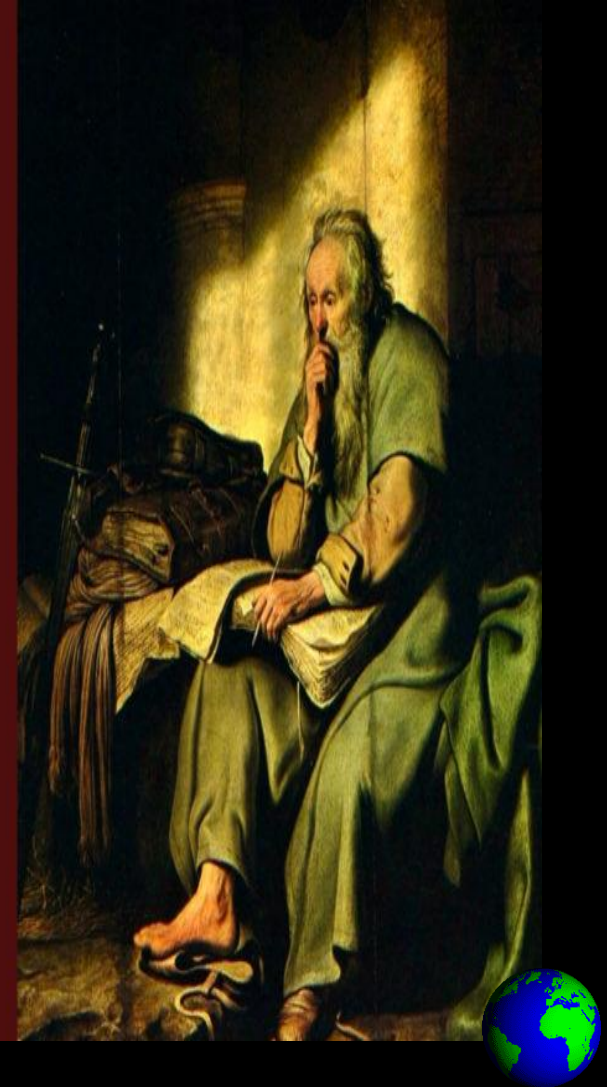

Conclusion

5. Fulfilling the Global Commission (Acts 28)

Unstoppable Mission: The final chapters of Acts detail Paul taking the Gospel to the ends of the earth, culminating in his Roman imprisonment, where he "preaching the kingdom of God... with all confidence, no man forbidding him" (Acts 28:31).

The primary mission of the remnant is the proclamation of the Three Angels' Messages (Revelation 14) to "every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people."

The Book of Acts teaches that God uses a combination of institutional church structures, personal testimonies, and even providential hardships to spread the Gospel to places it wouldn't have reached otherwise.

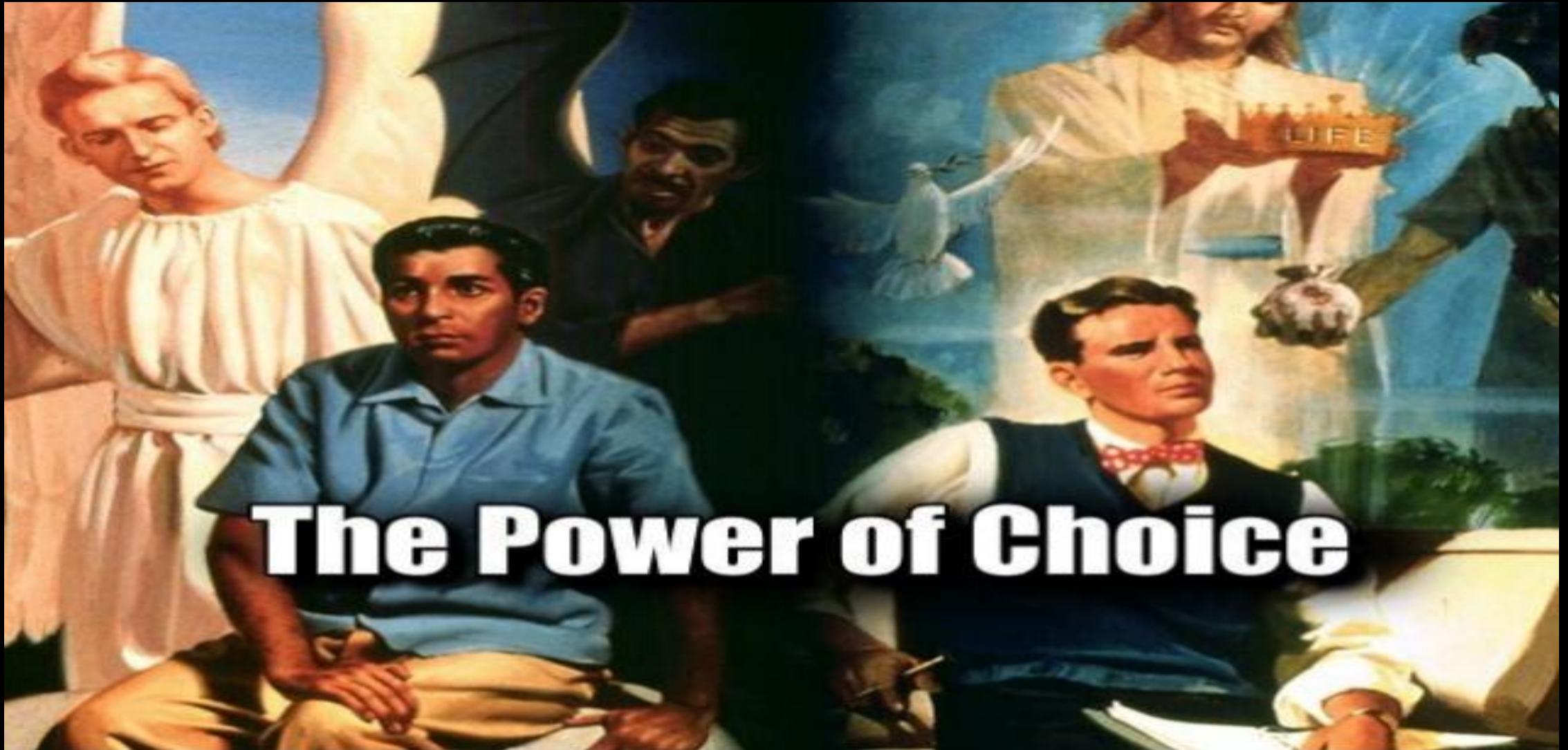

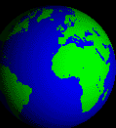
