Health Snippet – Blood Orange

Health Benefits of Blood Orange (Seek Medical Advice)

A blood orange is *Citrus × sinensis* with dark crimson or blood-colored flesh. It looks like a normal orange on the outside. Common types Moro (deep color and tart), Tarocco (sweet and lightly pigmented), and Sanguinello.

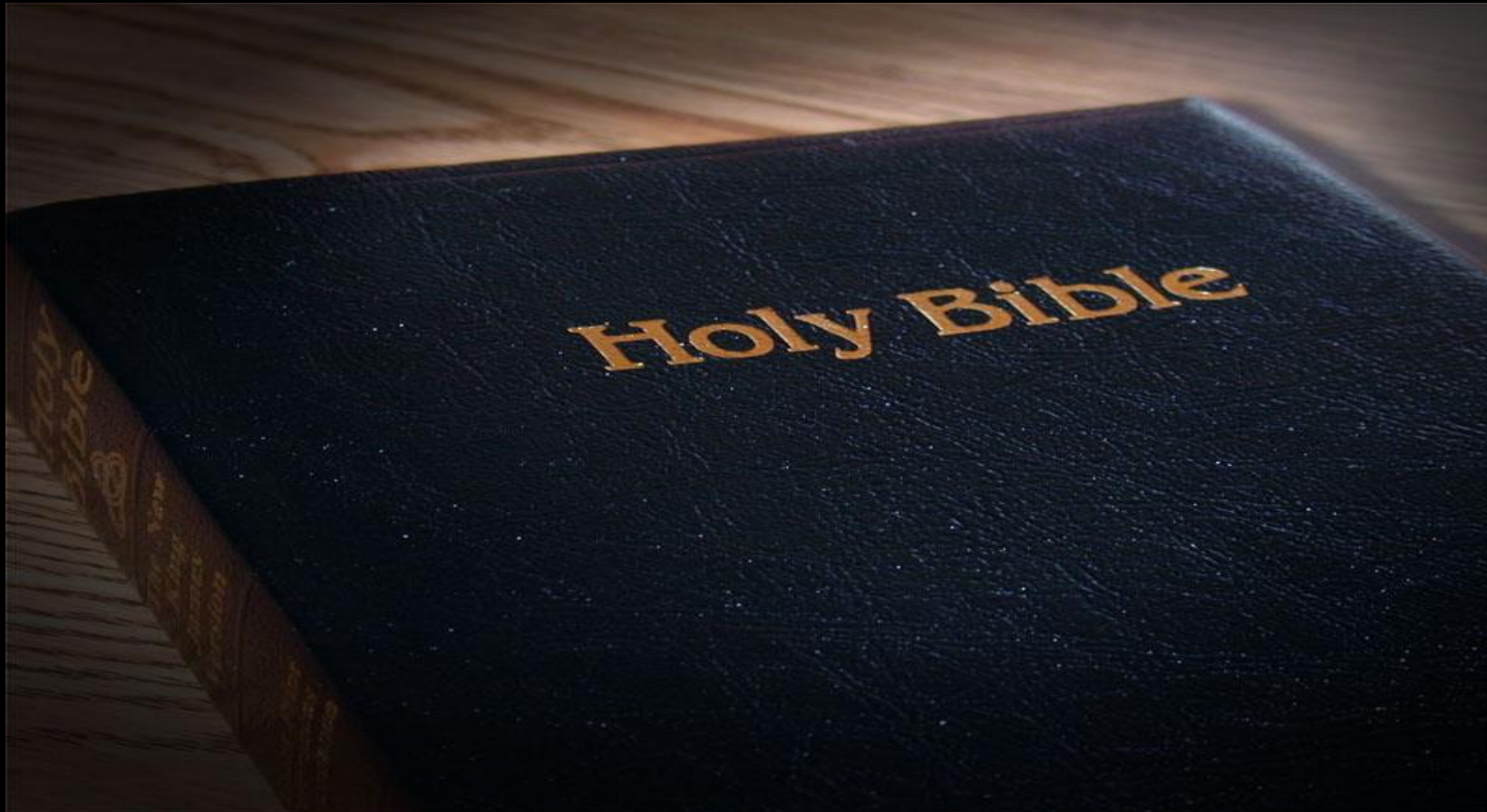

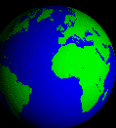

Introduction

Chapter 1: Spiritual Blessings in Christ

God's sovereign grace, election, and the grand cosmic plan to "gather together in one all things in Christ".

Focus: Emphasizes our secure identity in Christ and the sealing ministry of the Holy Spirit as a guarantee of our heavenly inheritance, pointing toward the ultimate restoration of universal unity at the end of the great controversy.



Introduction

Chapter 2: Saved by Grace and Reconciled

Salvation as an unearned gift of grace turning spiritual death into life, and the breaking down of ethnic and social barriers (the dividing wall between Jews and Gentiles).

Focus: Highlights the horizontal reconciliation among believers matching our vertical reconciliation with God, forming one new spiritual humanity and temple.

Introduction

Chapter 3: The Mystery of the Gospel Revealed

Paul's ministry to the Gentiles, unveiling the hidden truth that non-Jews are co-heirs in Christ.

Focus: Stresses that the church serves as a living demonstration of God's manifold wisdom to the watching cosmic powers. Paul's prayer models a life rooted deeply in the strengthening power of the Holy Spirit.

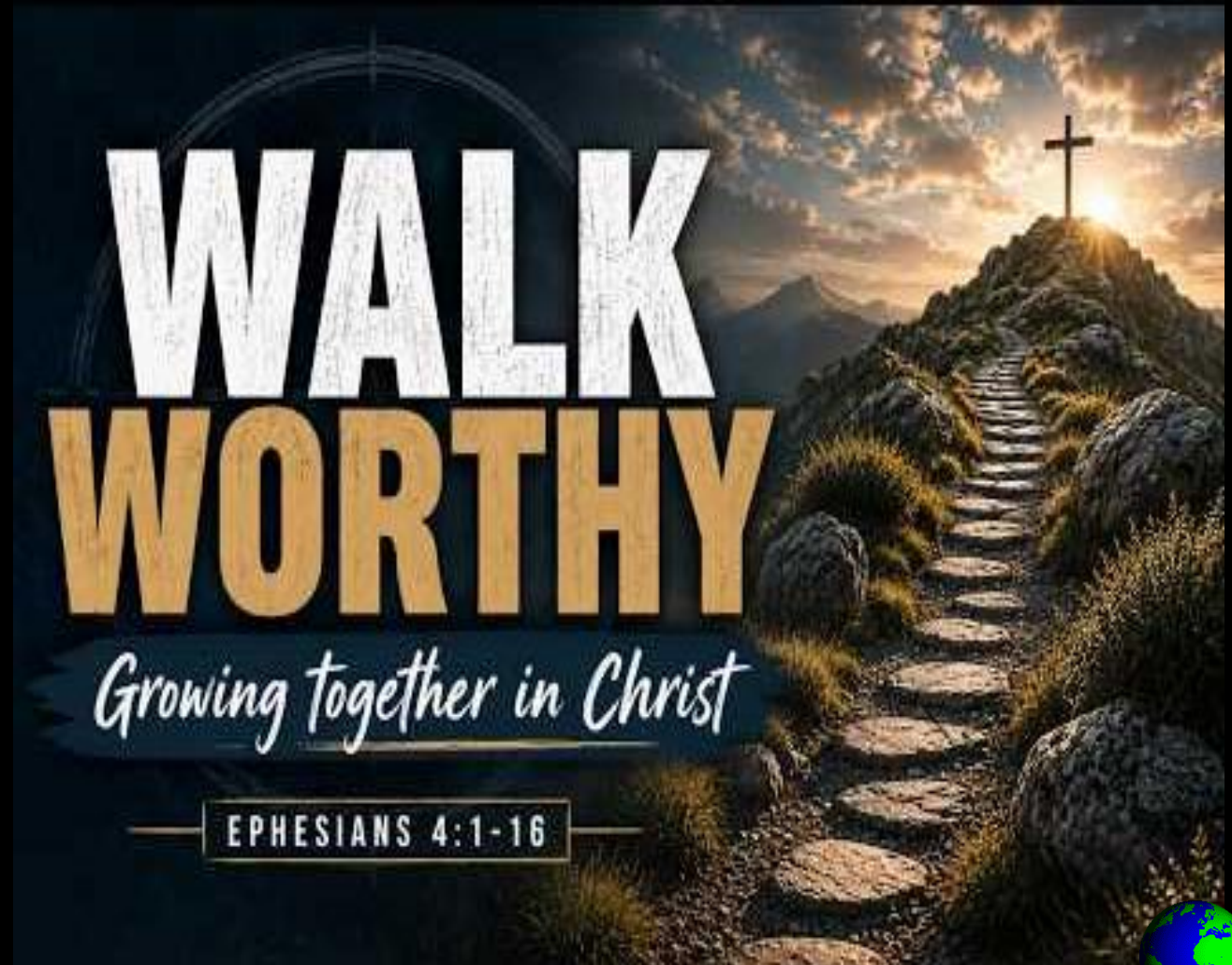


Introduction

Chapter 4: Walking Worthy in Church Unity

Practical unity, Christian humility, and the distribution of spiritual gifts to build up the body of Christ.

Focus: Features the Adventist emphasis on the "seven-fold oneness" (one body, one Spirit, one hope, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God). Unity is viewed as something we already possess in Christ yet must actively cultivate and preserve through forbearance and love.



Introduction

Chapter 5: Walking in Light and Love

Ethical transformation, casting off the old lifestyle of darkness, and living wisely.

Focus: Reenacting the gospel story within human relationships—specifically mirrored through self-sacrificing, Christ-like love and mutual submission in marriage and daily conduct.



Introduction

Chapter 6: Spiritual Warfare and the Armor of God

Standing firm against unseen demonic forces, familial duties, and spiritual defense.

Focus: Highlights the reality of the Great Controversy between Christ and Satan at an individual and corporate level. Believers are called to rely completely on divine power through unceasing prayer and the putting on of Christ's character (the Armor of God).

Chapter 1: Chosen in Christ for the End-Time Plan

Spiritual Riches: Believers are blessed with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places.

The Remnant Identity: God chose a people before the foundation of the world to be holy and without blame, emphasizing character development over mere lineage.

The Cosmic Goal: God's ultimate purpose in the dispensation of the fullness of times is to gather and unite all things in Christ.

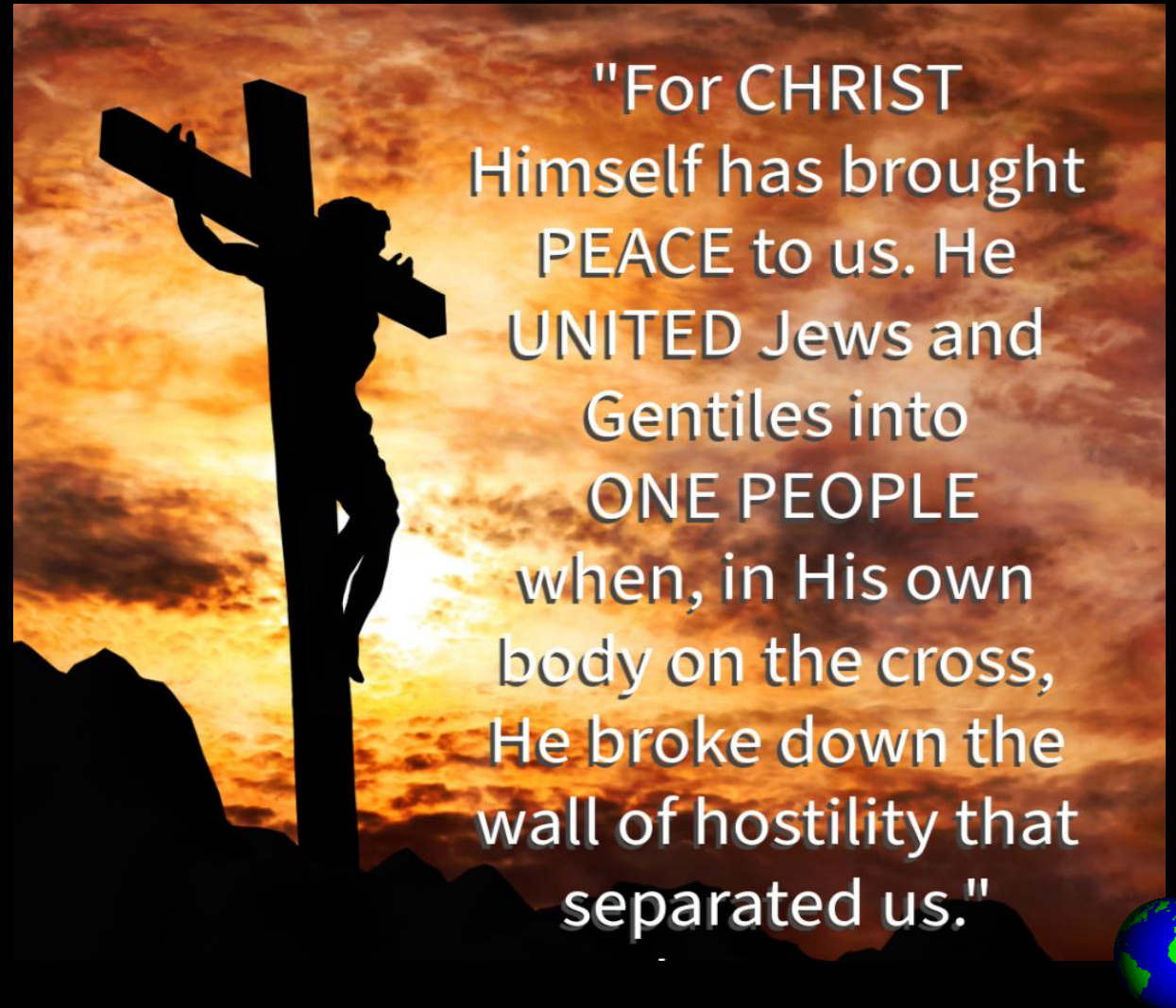
3 - *Lessons in the book of Ephesians*

Chapter 2: Grace, Resurrection, and Unity

Saved by Grace: Sinners are dead in trespasses, but God quickens them together with Christ, raising them to walk in newness of life.

The Breaking Down of Barriers: The cross abolishes the enmity (the ceremonial law/divine barriers), making Jew and Gentile one body.

The Household of God: The remnant is built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Jesus Christ as the chief cornerstone.



"For CHRIST Himself has brought PEACE to us. He UNITED Jews and Gentiles into ONE PEOPLE when, in His own body on the cross, He broke down the wall of hostility that separated us."

Chapter 3: The Mystery of the Gospel Revealed

The Mystery Unfolded:

The inclusion of all nations into the body of Christ is a profound revelation of God's manifold wisdom.

Strengthened by the Spirit:

Paul prays for the inner man to be strengthened with might, enabling God's people to comprehend the breadth, length, depth, and height of Christ's love.

Chapter 4: Walking Worthy in Unity and Truth

The Sevenfold Unity: The church is anchored by one body, one Spirit, one hope, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, and one God.

Gifts for Maturity: Christ gives gifts to prepare the saints for the work of the ministry, building up the body until all reach unity in the faith.

Putting Off the Old Man: Believers are called to lay aside lying, stealing, corrupt communication, and bitterness, being renewed in the spirit of their mind.

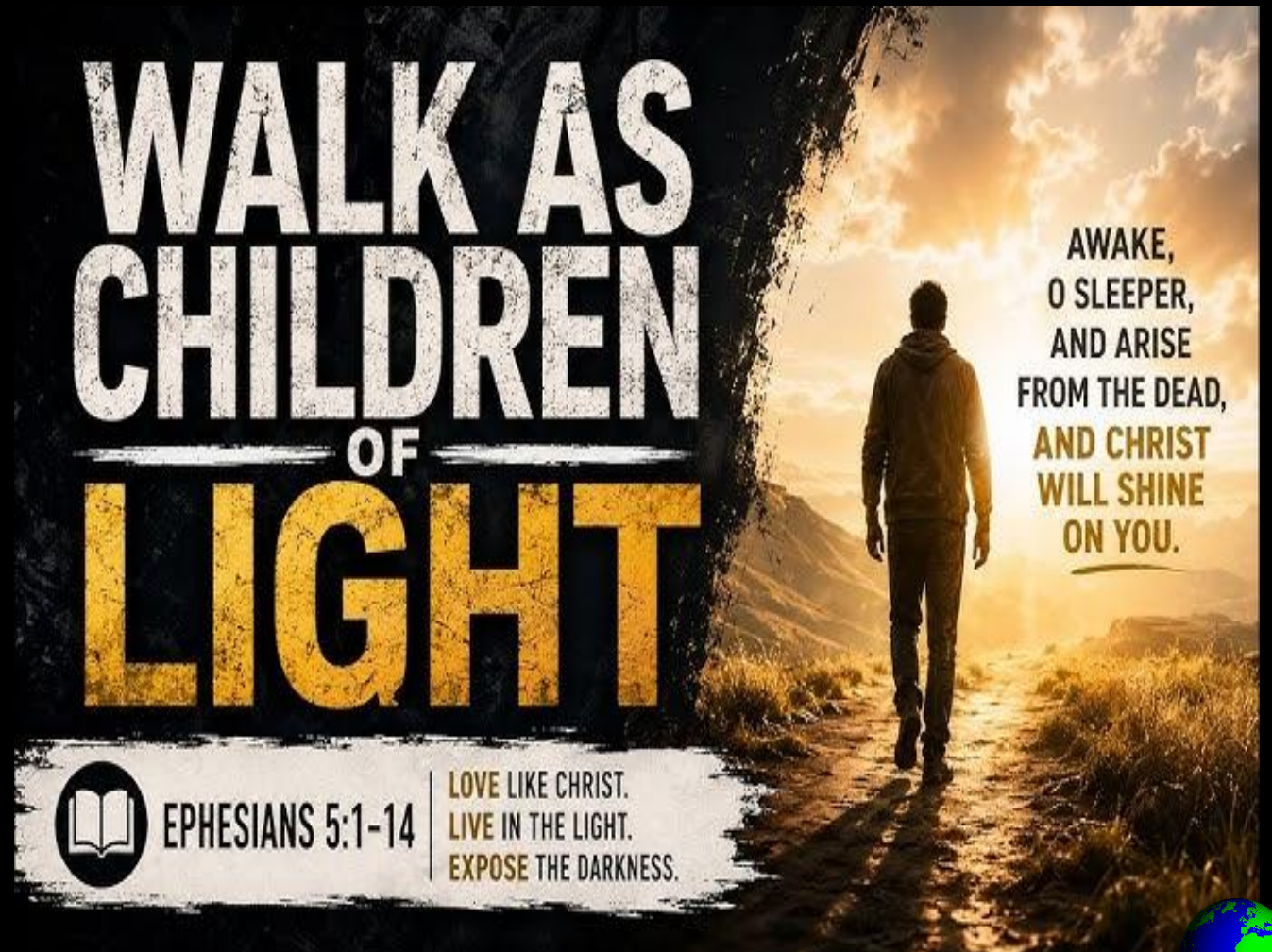

Chapter 5: Walking as Children of Light

Imitating God: Walk in love, as Christ also loved us and gave Himself an offering and a sacrifice to God.

Separation from Darkness: Have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them.

The Bride of Christ: Christian marriage mirrors the pure, sacrificial relationship between Christ and His church.



Conclusion

Chapter 6: The Remnant at War and the Armor of God

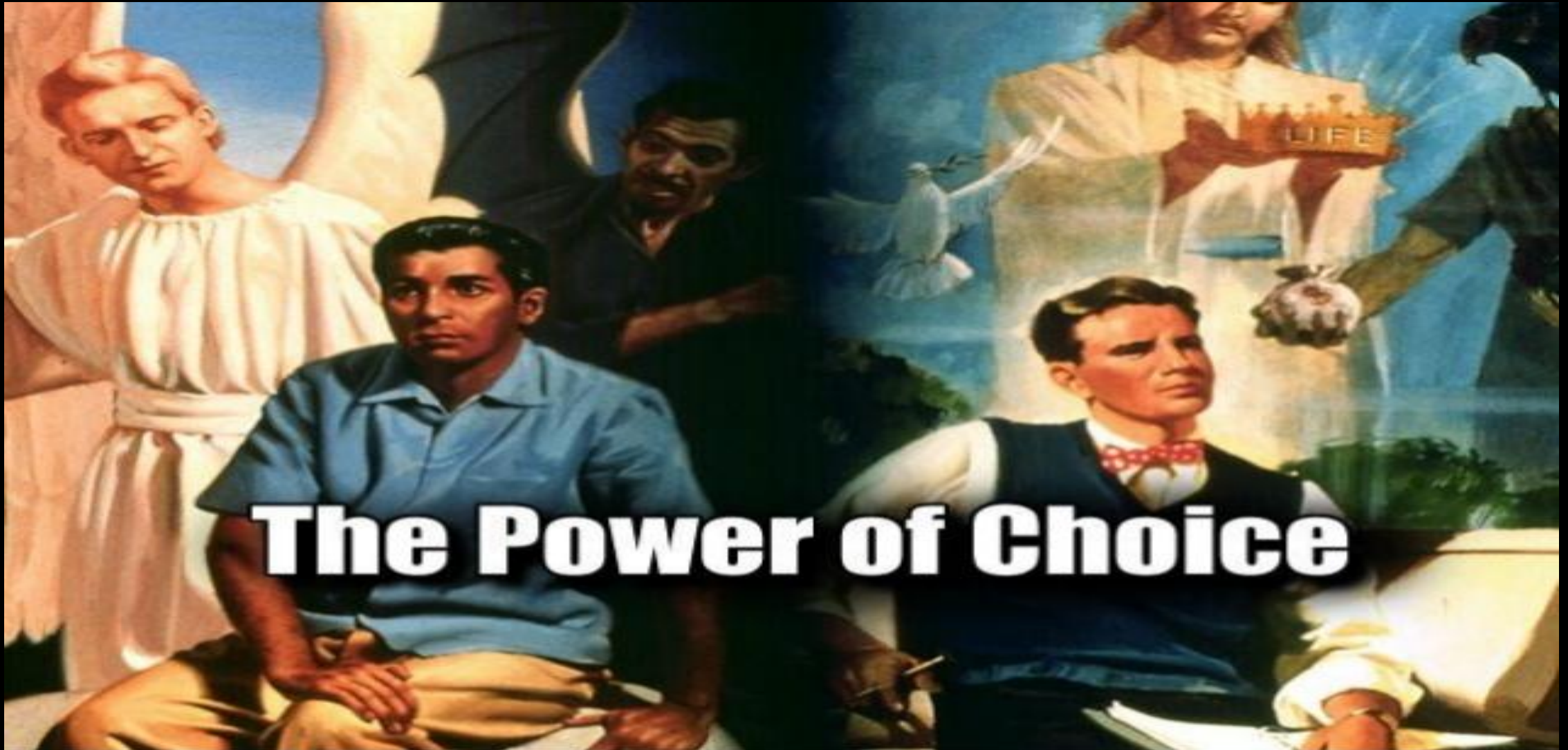
The Final Conflict: The remnant does not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, powers, and spiritual wickedness in high places.

The Whole Armor: Stand firm by putting on the belt of truth, breastplate of righteousness, shoes of the preparation of the gospel of peace, shield of faith, helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit (the Word of God).

Pervasive Prayer: Pray always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, watching with all perseverance.

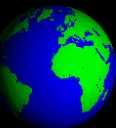
